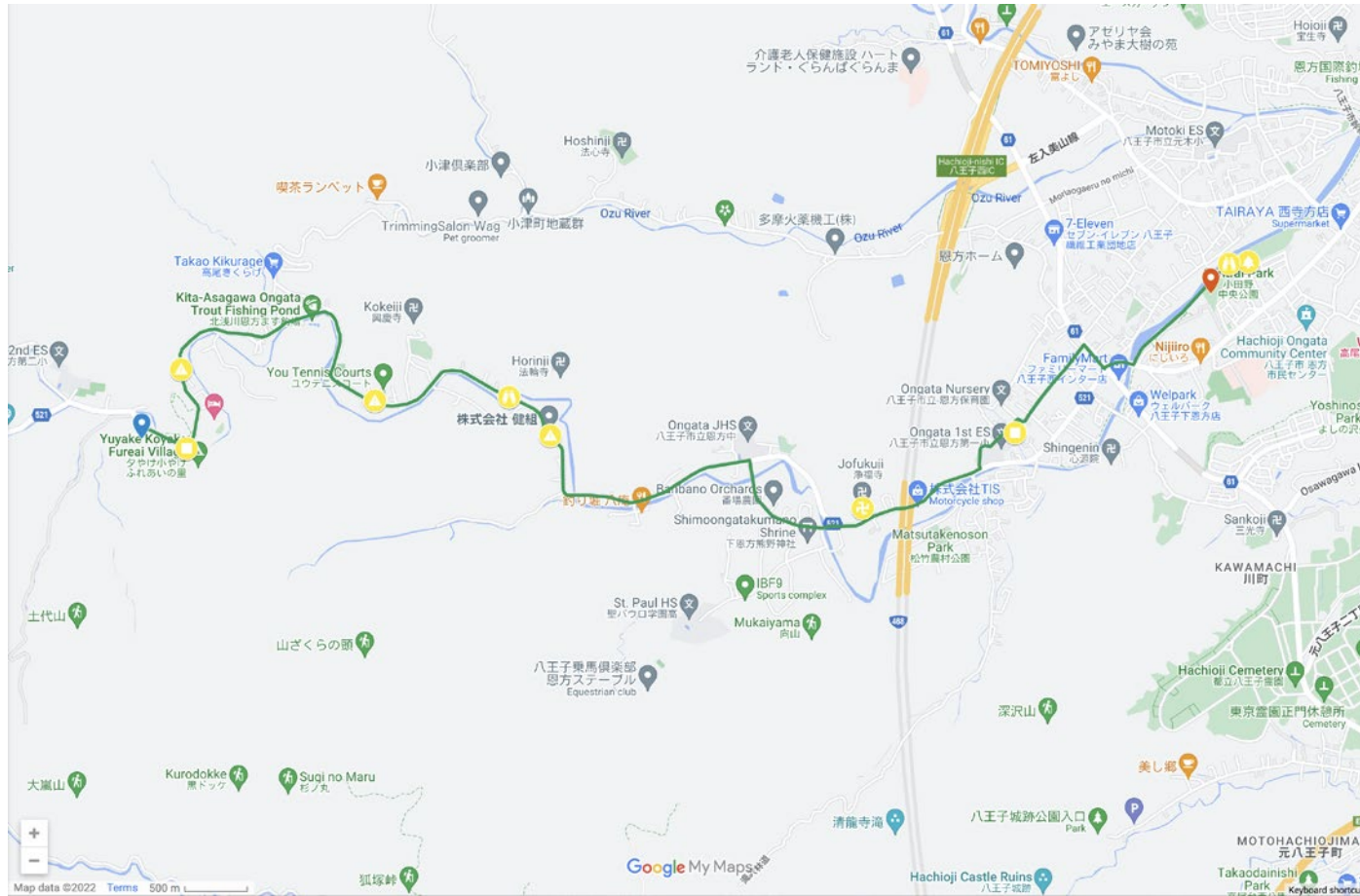

🍽️ Calorie consumption	around 300 kcal
👣 Number of steps	around 9290 steps

* These are estimates given for a person, weight 60kg, moving at 4km per hour, walking 10 min.=30kcal, one step=70cm.

A facility for various experiences including agriculture, forestry and recreation modeled on the nursery rhyme "Yuyake Koyake" (the red sunset sky and the after-sunset orange sky). The facility incorporates dining areas and accommodation (day-trip bathing also possible). In summer, you can also use the camping grounds.
Opening hours: 9:00-16:30 (close at 16:00 from November to March)
Admission fee: Adults 200 yen, Junior High School age and younger 100 yen, children ages under four free.
Free parking spaces available (200)

Jofukuji Temple



The entire belt including the temple and the hill behind encompass the remains of Jofukuji Castle remains, said to be the 14th to 15th century fortress. Magnificent weeping cherry trees blossom in spring.

Hachioji Kuruma Ningyo Nishikawa Koryu Troup practice area



A puppet theatre where puppets handled by a single puppeteer each sitting on a seat with roller wheels called Rokuro Kuruma conceived at the end of the Edo period. A practice area can be found here. (* Tours require bookings)
